

LOUDON COUNTY License Plate & Vehicle Registration

Loudon County residents can obtain or make changes to their vehicle registrations and obtain vehicle license plates at the County Clerk's Satellite Office in **Lenoir City** at 510 Hwy 321 near City Hall from 8am-4:30pm (***closed from 1-2pm for lunch***) or at the main office in Loudon at 101 Mulberry Street, Loudon.

A list of the required registration documents and info about handicap placards is online at **www.loudoncountyclerk.org**. Scroll down and click on '**Motor Vehicles.**'

Driver's License services are not yet available in Lenoir City, just vehicle licenses & tags.

Other services offered at **Loudon Court Clerk's Main Office** are:

- **business license**
- **marriage license**
- **register a boat** or watercraft

NEW-TO-STATE RESIDENTS – to **get a Tennessee Driver's License**:

- You have **30 days** to obtain your TN Driver's License
- You must go to a **Full-Service Driver Center** to obtain your new TN driver's license.
- A list of full-service centers can be found online and an appointment made.
- **Required documents** (*also needed for TN REAL ID's*):
 - previous state issued Driver's License or ID
 - proof of citizenship (*birth certificate...*)
 - proof of any name change (*marriage certificate...*)
 - proof of social security number
 - 2 proofs of Tennessee residency (*bills, deeds...*)
- **Documents** must be original/certified. **Other** accepted documents are listed online.



Hand Gun Permits: Only **Full-Service** Drivers Centers can issue & renew carry permits. **www.tn.gov/safety/tnhp/handgun/faq.html 615-251-8590.**
(*Most handgun permits from other states are recognized in Tennessee for **6 months.***)

MOVERS from within TENNESSEE—to **change your TN Driver's License Address**

go to the Loudon Driver's License Office—downstairs at 101 Mulberry Street, Loudon--but first scroll down to '**Drivers License Services**' at **www.loudoncountyclerk.org/** or **www.tn.gov/** so you'll come prepared with all the necessary documents. The Loudon office hours are 8am-4:00pm Monday-Friday (***closed for lunch from 1-2pm***). This office does NOT do **CDL renewals** (*unless they are downgraded to a Class D*). Call **865-458-2916** or **865-458-2726** for info.

Other services offered at the **Loudon Driver's License Office downstairs** are:

- add **veteran** status to Driver's License (*DD-214 required*)
- **change a name** on a Driver's License—due to marriage, court order or divorce
- obtain a **Driver's Handbook** or motorcycle study book
- obtain a **TN REAL ID**—Since **May 7, 2026**, everyone over the age of 18 is required to have a Real ID to board domestic flights or access federal buildings (*aside from federal courts*).

- **replace** a lost or stolen Driver's License
- **renew** a Driver's License or ID
- **update a Driver's License photo**
